ANIMOTO



Free website where you can **create**, download, and share your own **videos**. Log in for free via Facebook account or a Google access. You can **drag and drop** your *pictures* and *videos* into one ready-made template or just start from scratch.



Simple to use.



Short videos.

COGGLE



Mind-map creator / graphic organisers.

- brainstorm ideas
- pre-writing strategy
- summarise topics
- work on vocabulary



Collaborative work. You may add text, images and links

EDMODO



Widely used website and app to **create virtual classrooms**.

- ✓ **No e-mail** required.
- ✓ Access classes via a class code
- ✓ **Parents may have access** to students' performance marks.
- ✓ Create **assignments, polls, posts, libraries**, etc.
- ✓ Create subgroups within your class.



Safe environment. Private message section. Make libraries with your PC files or from your Google drive.



You need to teach users how to use it and navigate the site.

EDPUZZLE



Website and app. Create a class, upload a **video** and **design activities**. You may **add**:

- **voice notes**,
- **open question** and/or
- **True-False ones**.

Teachers can **correct on site** and provide **feedback**.



You can use videos created by other users. You can crop videos and use shorter segments



It may look difficult at first, but it is worth the while.

EDUCAPLAY



A **webpage** that allows to **create activities** and **assign** them to your students. There is space to **exchange ideas** and **dictation** for those who need it. Teacher can **correct some activities online**.



Export results to spreadsheets.

ENGLISH MEDIA LAB



Website that offers **free exercises**. You may find some based on **grammar topics, vocabulary** and/or **pronunciation**.

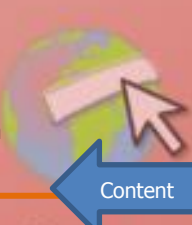


Most exercises are presented as games, which is engaging for students.



No interaction among students. Ask students to send you a screenshot with the answers.

Apps & Sites that may prove useful during lockdown

FLIPGRID



Website / App useful for students to upload students' **videos** with content and share them with the teacher & peers in a class. Teacher can **provide feedback** on their performance. Peers may react to videos as well. Focus on **Speaking** mainly. Access "[teachers' guide](#)".



Add different activities in each group. Ss may blur their faces if shy.



Time needed to familiarise with site but it's worth the while!

GENIAL.LY



An easy-to-use, **free** web tool to create **interactive visual content**, such as **presentations** and **infographics**. Teachers may be invited to edit the creation.



Really engaging.



You cannot download productions, always online.

GOOGLE CLASSROOM



A site to **create virtual classrooms**. It can be used as a space to interact with learners. It is connected to Google Drive and other features/apps related to Google. If an institution has an ".edu" account, it may apply for the G Suite pack for free.



Assignments can be corrected on site and feedback sent on the spot.



Participants need a Gmail account - a drawback with underaged students.

GOOGLE FORMS



Google Forms

You may be familiar with Google forms. Did you know you may create **activities** that **self-correct**? You may insert:
⇒ images
⇒ videos from YouTube
Possibilities may be endless depending on your creativity. Teachers can see answers online.



It may take time to create but it's helpful. You can re-use forms. You can analyse class results by means of the pie charts created.



Students may need an e-mail address or share answers.

HANGOUTS



A component of the Google family that allows **conversations** and **video conferences** between 2 or more users.



You only need to download the app.



You need a Gmail account. Up to 10 participants.

KAHOOT!



Games for **revising vocabulary**, **multiple choice** questions. Create **polls**, **formative assessment** activities, **slides** to teach, **practise spelling**, etc. In the paid version, you can download and track results.



Fun and engaging. Premium version free now. Online game or "**homework**" version with the **challenge** option.



Spelling & slides are part of the features available in the paid version as some other information.

Apps & Sites that may prove useful during lockdown

LINO



Lino is an online web **sticky note service** that can be used to post **memos**, to-do **lists**, **ideas**, and **photos** anywhere on an online web canvas. Collaborative tool. You can create as many as you like.



Easy to use and share. Log in is not necessary. Colourful. Video embedding allowed.

LIVE WORKSHEETS



Interactive worksheets. You may use those made by other users or design your own. **Comments** may be sent via email *if students have registered*. These handouts may be used to develop comprehension skills.

You can create

- Unlimited public worksheets.
- Up to 30 private worksheets
- Up to 10 workbooks to share with up to 100 students.



You can share them externally and get answers tracked in different ways. Most worksheets can also be downloaded as PDF.

MENTIMETER



A website that allows **interaction** to engage your students through **polls**, **quizzes**, **Q&A** sessions and much more.

You can **download** results as pdf.



Engaging. A good way to gather/exchange data and make presentations.



The free version allows a maximum of 7 days to collect votes.

NEWSPAPER JAGUARPAW



It is a website to create your own **newspaper articles** where photos can be included.

ONLINE WORKSHEET GENERATOR



A website that allows users to create **handouts**. **Word Scramble**, **word search** and **minimal pairs** are **free**.



Some variety. You may create communicative tasks where patterns become input.



You need to pay to access premium worksheets. It may be worth doing so.

Apps & Sites that may prove useful during lockdown

PADLET



Online **dashboard** to **share ideas, videos, images**. You can add **links** and **audios**, too. It allows **interaction** among participants. Great tool for **writing** (short) texts as well. Let your creativity soar! It may prove useful to collect assignments and get classmates to comment on other posts.



Collaborative.
User friendly



In the free version, you can create up to 3 boards.

PDF ESCAPE



This website allows you to **add fields** to a **pdf file** for **users to write in**. You just upload your pdf file and add text or areas to include information.

⚠ Do not forget to acknowledge the original author of the pdf you choose to adjust!



Great alternative to adjust existing pdfs so that users may write on them.

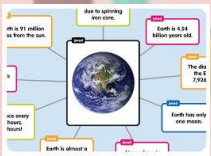


Few users reported not to have found the information added after saving.

POPPLET



Mind-map creator - **graphic organisers**. Users can **work collaboratively**. It may be used to, **brainstorm, summarise topics**, group **vocabulary** areas or any other way to **synthesise** content.



Collaboratively. You can include text, images, links and drawings.



The webpage does not work fine unless you have an update version of Java.

POWTOON



PowToon is an online tool that **creates dynamic videos**. There are many options and **templates** available for you to choose from. Your students can create one themselves to present some information to the class.



Excellent visuals and tool to share ideas and give out a message.



Free images are available for 1 day approx. Then, a lock appears next to them. You cannot download videos.

QUIZLET



A website & app to work with **vocabulary** mainly. You can include **images** (diagram) and **label** up to 8 items in it. You may **adopt** and **adapt** materials created by other users. You may **adjust creations** to **reading, grammar**, etc. using your creativity. 5 options to use **without the need of the teacher** with **self-correction**. **Test** option available. ⚠ **"Live"** feature (game) like **Kahoot**.



Engaging. Ss can work alone – **autonomy**. Collaboratively creation of material. **Audio** available.



There are interesting features in the paid version.

Apps & Sites that may prove useful during lockdown

SMALL PDF



It helps to **convert** and **edit files**. e.g., pages of a **pdf book** can be cut and **shared** with the students.

⚠ Suggestion: Do not use a whole unit, divide it in a couple of pages only



You can continue using your textbook as in class.



Free trial version for 14 days.

NO Tutorial

THE TEACHER'S CORNER



Create **crosswords**, **word searches**, **word scramble activities**, **cloze** handouts, **match up makers**, printable **calendar**, "telling **time**" worksheets, free **Math** worksheets, **word clouds** and **many more**.

⚠ Great to combine with **Quizlet & Kahoot!**



Variety. Download sheets. You can edit font, title, etc.

TOOLS FOR EDUCATORS



A website where you may design **word searches**, **dice makers**, printable **board games**, **crosswords** puzzle makers, **bingo** board makers, **maze** makers, **dominoes** makers, **spelling** worksheet makers, **tracing** worksheets, **certificate** templates, etc.



Lots of variety. Download sheets. You may create communicative tasks where patterns become input.



No Tutorial

VOCABULARY HANDOUT MAKER



It is an online worksheet **template** that allows you to make **handouts** for students with **images** and **custom text**. **Font** type and **size** may be **modified**.



Customise to your needs using the alternatives the website provides.



If a term you want to use is not included in the pre-set list, you cannot add it.

VOCAROO



Audio recording tool. Log in is not necessary. Easy to share: a URL link, a QR code. You can embed and/or download the recording.



You can download files.



Recordings disappear after some months. Inappropriate ads may appear while using the site.

Apps & Sites that may prove useful during lockdown

VOICE THREAD



Collaborative, multimedia slide show that holds images, documents, and videos and allows people to navigate slides and **leave comments** in 5 ways - **using voice** (with a mic or telephone), **text**, **audio file**, or **video** (via a webcam). All users have access to the answers. Accessible from different devices such as cell phones, laptops, tablets, etc. Watch out with connectivity.



Language skills are integrated.



No interaction at the same time. Only five free Voicethreads.

VOKI



Voki is an educational tool that allows the creation of an **avatar** to whom you can **add voice**. You can do so by writing a text or uploading a file with your voice, among other options. The avatar may be **customised** to look like an animated cartoon, a historical figure, animals or even students themselves. Great for opportunities to practise **speaking**.



Great not to expose underaged learners.



You cannot download the products unless you pay.



Tutorial

WRITE & IMPROVE



Interactive platform to practise **writing** for Cambridge Exams. Students will need to photograph their work and send it to the teacher; sharing is only allowed in the paid version.



The tool corrects and provides feedback.



Teachers cannot monitor progress with the free version.

No Tutorial

ZOOM



Web and App tool for **videoconferences** and **webinars**. Its free version offers 2 possibilities: **1 to 1 unlimited** and meetings up to **100 participants** that may last up to **30/40 min**. There is a **chat window**, you may **share the screen** of your device. *Break out rooms* to make participants **work in groups**. Headset needed!



No e-mail address required. Screen sharing. You can record session.



Free version: 30-40 minutes. Security issues risen these last few days.
